ENTRIES/FEES: a) Make checks payable to: High Point Equestrian Center; b) Refund Policy: Before closing date less \$20 handling fee. No Refunds after closing date; c) Negative coggins in-state within 12 months, out-of-state within 24 months. Coggins must accompany entry; d) Entries must be received by closing date. Entries received after closing date are subject to a \$15 late fee.

WARM-UP: Ride times will be scheduled as to allow warm-up in the indoor arena.

STABLING FEES: Day stalls available for \$25 per day.

AWARDS: Prizes and six ribbons per class. Year End Champion & Reserve Champion Dressage and Eventing.

ARENA: Sand/Rubber composite in 20 x 60 meter indoor arena. Combined Tests in 20 x 40 arena when specified. Outdoor jumping arena on grass footing.

RIDE TIMES: Posted one day prior to show at www.rideirishhorses.com/shows.htm .

OTHER: All dogs must be on a leash at all times.

SERIES INFO: Special awards for competitors that compete in at least three of the eight shows and have the highest combined scores. Awards will be given for each division (Intro, Training, First, Starter, BN and N).
